



## SWORD OF THE SPIRIT MINISTRIES CHILDREN'S MINISTRY SAFETY POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

In order to provide a safety environment for the children<sup>1</sup> that attend Sunday morning services at Sword of the Spirit Ministries (Sword), the following procedures will be implemented during children's church<sup>2</sup>:

Children's Ministry will began at 11:00am for Nursery (ages 2 years to 6 years) and Children's Church at 11:15am (7 years and older). Children are not allowed in the Children's Ministry designated areas prior to these times.
<u>All</u> parents/legal guardians of the children attending Children's Ministry are required to remain in the building with their child. Parents/legal guardians may not drop-off their child and leave the facility without their child for any reason.
<u>ALL</u> children should be signed-in and out by a Parent or legal Guardian.
During pick-up, a <u>ll</u> children are required to be signed-out by the same parent/legal guardian that signed-in the child.
No child shall be released to anyone other than the parent/legal guardian that signed-in the child, unless that parent/legal guardian has given expressed permission in writing to release the child to another during drop-off.
For the trust and safety of the parents and children of Sword of the Spirit Ministries, we will not release a child to a person that child does not know.
Children's Ministry volunteers should be notified before drop-off of any parental custody issues regarding the release of children. An official court-ordered document signed by Judge must be submitted to the church administration office and the Children's Ministry leader for safety and record keeping purposes.
To maintain order and safety, <u>ALL</u> children will remain in Children's Ministry until the <u>end of morning service</u> , except emergency cases and special situations.

<sup>2</sup> For the purpose of the regulations under this policy, Sword of the Spirit Ministries Children's Ministry includes Children's Church, Sunday School and Nursery.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>1</sup> For the purpose of the regulations under this policy, Children are defined as a person under the age of majority under Maryland Law.





No child shall be removed from the Sword of the Spirit Ministries facility by a
volunteer for any reason without the expressed permission of the child's parent or
legal guardian.

☐ Children shall be supervised by an adult volunteers at all times. Parent volunteers will be required at times to enforce safety practices.
